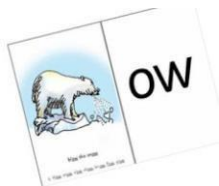


Red ditty - 1/2 Lesson

Spell review.

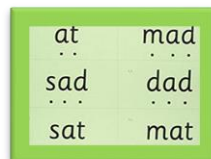
Speedy Sounds from Storybook

Tweak pronunciation if needed

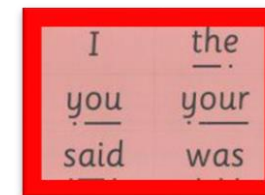
Speedy Green Words From the story



Fred in your head – when you push the card forward read the word.

Repeat with increasing pace

Say the word and ask chn to repeat.

Discuss the sounds that try to trick us.

Say the word. Ask chn to repeat.

Partner Practice









Speed sounds – focus on those circled
